CONVENTION REPORT

The International Ship Masters' Association Grand Lodge convened on Friday morning, February 6, 2015, at Duluth, MN. "Deep Blue is the New Green," was the convention theme.

Grand President Capt. **Robert Schallip** presented his report covering his year in office. He attended a number of ISMA and other functions around the Great Lakes, including the memorial service for Grand Traverse Lodge #23 member and PGP Capt. **Dean Hobbs** early in 2014. **Bob** also attended the spring Blessing of the Fleet as well as the fall Great Lakes Memorial Service in Detroit. He made shipboard visits to a couple of ISMA Past Grand Presidents. "I have truly enjoyed the friendship and fellowship extended to me this past year as I traveled around. It gives a sense of purpose, and I wish Captain **Joe Walters** the best as he takes the helm for the coming year," he concluded.

Capt. John Sarns, Chairman of the Navigation, Engineering and Legislative Committee (NELC) reported on committee activities over the past year. John and committee members Capt. Tom McMullen and Capt. Patrick Beard attended numerous meetings, wrote letters, and discussed issues.

Other committee reports were presented, including Newsletter, Scholarship, Website, and Grand President's Award. Scholarship Committee chairman Capt. **Seann O'Donoughue** read thank you letters from the three award recipients. A Grand President's Award went to Capt. **Dave Miller** (Buffalo Lodge #1) and the crew of the *Manistee* for rescuing a diver in the Straits of Mackinac. Another went to Capt. **Norman Raymond** (Detroit Lodge #7) and crew on a vessel that rescued two people in the Detroit River in 2013.

Green Bay Lodge #18's proposal requesting that the US Coast Guard alter the lighted characteristics of the Milwaukee Breakwater Light (LLN 20635) at the north side of the main entrance to Milwaukee Harbor (Chart 14924) from FL R 10s to FL(2) R 10s was approved unanimously and the NELC will pursue this request. In addition to Grand Lodge business, there were a number of guest speakers who gave informative talks, largely centered on "green" initiatives on the Lakes.

From the NELC

At the Grand Lodge Convention in Duluth, Green Bay Lodge #18 submitted a proposal directing the NELC to petition the USCG about changing Milwaukee Harbor Breakwater Light from a single flashing red light (10 sec) to a group flashing light (FL (2) R 10 sec) to make the light more distinguishable from shore lights.

Immediately after the convention the NELC contacted the USCG, and within just a few days received a positive response. The USCG concurs with the proposal, and they intend to publish the proposed change in the Notice to Mariners for the next eight (8) weeks. If no objections are voiced, the change will be made in mid-May.

Here is the response received from the US Coast Guard:

I have received your request to change the characteristic on Milwaukee Harbor Breakwater Light (LLNR 20635). I concur with your concerns and the change from FL R (2) 20s to FL (2) 10s is not a difficult task. In accordance with our policy we have to advertise the proposed characteristic change in the Local Notice to Mariners for a period of 8 weeks. Unless we receive strong objections, you can expect the change to take place in mid May 2015.

Industry Newsbriefs -

Boat Trip Raffle Winner

Great Lakes water levels are predicted to rise to nine inches above average this summer. The Lakes will be generally over two feet higher than their record low levels in January 2013.

- The President's fiscal year 2016 budget funding for the Civil Works program of the US Army Corps of Engineers includes more than \$69 million for USACE Detroit District projects around the Great Lakes.
- On April 1, 2015, a notice was published in the *Federal Register* announcing that the US Coast Guard is changing Light List distribution. Electronic, online versions will continue to be free, but the Coast Guard will no longer produce printed Light List volumes. - The Great Lakes Maritime Task Force (ISMA is a member) released their 2014 Annual Report, available at <u>www.glmtf.org/</u> <u>category/annual-reports/</u>.
- US-flag iron ore shipments for March 2015 were nearly 60 percent below the month's five-year average because of heavy ice and a lack of icebreaking on both sides of the border due to a number of mechanical issues.
- The opportunity to obtain an extended expiration date TWIC ended December 31, 2014. Renewal now requires the full enrollment process. However, the TWIC fee was reduced from \$129.75 to \$128 due to lower FBI fingerprint processing costs.
- Canadian Shipowners Association and Lake Carriers' Association will hold the Canada-US Maritime Gateway 2015 Conference in Ottawa, ON, from May 20-22, 2015. The conference will focus on new developments in the industry in a rapidly changing marketplace. Industry leaders as well as key political and governmental stakeholders will participate. - The US Army Corps of Engineers held a Great lakes Navigation Stakeholder Workshop in Chicago on April 14, 2015.
- The St. Lawrence Seaway Management Corporation marked the opening of the Seaway's 57th navigation season with the transit of the new *CWB Marquis* (Lodge #15 member Seann O'Donoughue, captain) through the St. Lambert Lock. Terence Bowles, SLSMC president and CEO, noted that he hopes 2015 will bring a repeat of the strong results in 2014, when the Seaway recorded 40 million tonnes of cargo.
- The US Senate Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation approved S. 373, the Vessel Incidental Discharge Act, in March 2015. This measure would replace overlapping and conflicting Federal and state regulations with a uniform Federal framework for vessel discharge regulation. The bill is expected to reach the Senate floor this spring.
