From Our Grand President

Search for a New Grand Lodge Secretary/ Treasurer

Our Grand Lodge Secretary/Treasurer, **Brian Eickel**, announced at this year's Grand Lodge meeting that he's interested in passing his duties along to someone else. Filling this important position presents an opportunity to improve the Grand Lodge recordkeeping methods currently in place. The processing of membership information and financial reporting can be made easier to make the Secretary/Treasurer's job less burdensome while ensuring accuracy. This may make the position more desirable for those of you considering it.

Streamlining the process of adding a new member's information to the Grand Lodge roster can be made. Currently the local lodge secretary/treasurers submit the membership forms to the Grand Lodge Secretary/Treasurer, who enters it into the Grand Lodge database spreadsheets. A new Grand Lodge database can be developed so the local lodge secretary/treasurer electronically transmits the new member's information directly into the Grand Lodge database spreadsheets. The original membership form with the local lodge seal can accompany this via regular mail to document the new member. The Grand Lodge database can then generate a new member's pennant number and with information taken from the spreadsheet produce a new membership certificate accompanied by a mailing address label. The local lodge secretary/treasurers can update their annual lodge membership in the same fashion so that the Grand Lodge accounting of members and dues is instantaneously accurate with no transfer of information required by the Grand Lodge Secretary/Treasurer.

The new Grand Lodge Secretary/Treasurer should be open to the development and implementation of a new database system. A candidate that possesses some knowledge of email data entry and processing spreadsheet information is beneficial but not necessary. The Grand Lodge can help develop and implement a new system. Some of our younger member-

ship having a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from a maritime academy may possess these skills. All demographics of our membership are encouraged to consider the potential of this Grand Lodge position. When a new system is in place, many of the Secretary/Treasurer duties can then be done remotely.

The position pays a \$4000 stipend and an \$800 expense reimbursement for attending the Grand Lodge convention. Anyone interested in the Grand Lodge Secretary/Treasurer position can email Grand President **William J. (Bill) Rabatsky** at rabatsky@sbcglobal.net.

WW II Merchant Marine Awards

On May 18, 2022, Lodge #12 member **Christopher Edyvean** attended the official ceremony to award the Congressional Gold Medal to the US Merchant Marine of WWII. The event was held at the Statuary Hall at the US Capitol with Speaker of the House **Nancy Pelosi** officiating. Ceremonial remarks were made by House Minority Leader **Kevin McCarthy**, Senate Minority Leader **Mitch McConnell**, Vice Admiral **Scott Buschman** (USCG Deputy Commandant for Operations), Rear Admiral **Michael Wettlaufer** (Commander, Military Sealift Command), **Lucinda Lessley** (MARAD Deputy Administrator), Rep. **John Garamendi**, and Rep. **Joe Courtney**. Colors were presented/retired by the US Merchant Marine Academy (Kings Point) Honor Guard. The Merchant Marine song "Heave Ho" was performed by a U.S. Navy vocal quartet. Ten WWII Merchant Mariners were in attendance. WWII MM veteran **Dave Yoho**, who went on to become a well-known motivational speaker & businessman, had the final remarks before Speaker **Pelosi** presented the medal. - The Chamber of Marine Commerce released their "2021 Great Lakes-St. Lawrence Seaway System Tonnage Activity" report. Overall, cargo shipments increased by 7% over 2020. See <https://www.marinedelivers.com/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/2021-Tonnage-Report-FINAL.pdf>.
- The US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) vessel *Thomas Jefferson* is on a mapping mission in Lake Erie.
- After a 2-year pause, Canal Days Maritime Heritage Festival returns to Port Colborne July 29 – August 1, 2022.
- The Marine Museum of the Great Lakes at Kingston, ON, participated in a community action dive and shoreline clean-up June 18 & 19, 2022.
- On June 12, 2022, the 72nd Annual Blessing of the Fleet was held at Ashtabula, OH.
- On June 9, 2022, Hamilton celebrated the STV *Pathfinder*'s return to sail training with a re-commissioning ceremony.

- Great Lakes passenger cruising has returned this season, and the cruise industry on the Lakes appears to be thriving.
- From July 19-21, 2022, the US National Maritime Center (NMC) is hosting a Merchant Mariner Examination Working Group meeting. See <https://mariners.coastguard.blog/2022/05/26/merchant-mariner-examination-workinggroup-update/>.
- Robotic buoys, using technology to record whale sounds in near real time can give scientists, mariners, and the public an idea of the location of North Atlantic right whales. Read more at <https://www.ourmidland.com/news/article/Robotic-buoys-developed-to-keep-Atlantic-right-17205153.php>.
- Marblehead (OH) Lighthouse is celebrating 200 years as a navigational aid and a tourist attraction as well. It is the oldest continuously operating lighthouse in the Great Lakes.
- May 18, 2022, marked the inaugural International Day for Women in Maritime.
- The Association of Canadian Port Authorities (ACPA) holds its 2022 Annual Conference in Toronto, June 20-23.
- On May 9, 2022, the US Maritime Administration (MARAD) announced that up to \$684.3 million is now available for Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP) grants – the highest level of funding ever available for the program.
- On May 16, 2022, the US DOT announced that Rear Admiral **Ann Phillips**, USN, Ret., was confirmed by the US Senate on May 10, and later sworn in as the 20th Administrator of the Maritime Administration (MARAD). She is the first woman to lead MARAD as administrator.
- On May 1, 2022, US MARAD announced a more than 50% increase in funding for the 2022 grants to be awarded for America's Marine Highway Program.
- On May 1, 2022, the Ontario government announced funding of \$8.7 million at Hamilton's Heddle Shipyards for investments in equipment and training.
- In April 2022, the Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority was awarded a \$9 million grant--from American Rescue Plan Act funding provided to the Ohio EPA--to expand and improve its dredging disposal site for silt from the Maumee River.
- Effective March 15, 2022, the US Coast Guard may not charge vessel inspection user fees for towing vessels using the Towing Safety Management System (TSMS) option for documenting compliance with Title 46 CFR, Subchapter M. This was directed by the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2022 (FY22 Omnibus), signed into law on March 15.
- In late April 2022, the US Army Corps of Engineers confirmed its lease of the new tugboat *Don Paul*, through Cleveland's Great Lakes Towing, for five years. The tug will primarily be used on Lake Erie between Buffalo and Toledo.
- On April 19, 2022, the US Coast Guard published Marine Safety Information Bulletin 02-21 Change 5 "COVID-19 Safety Requirements in the Maritime Transportation System". - On March 30, 2022, the US Coast Guard announced establishment of new base pilotage rates for the 2022 shipping season. See <https://mariners.coastguard.blog/2022/03/30/final-rule-great-lakes-pilotage-rates-2022-annual-review-and-revisions-to-methodology/>.
- On March 28, 2022, the US Coast Guard announced that it is seeking public input regarding modification of chart and navigational equipment carriage requirements.
