Extended Expiration Date TWICs End

The US Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has issued a notice stating that the opportunity to obtain a three-year Extended Expiration Date (EED) Transportation Worker Identification Card (TWIC) for \$60 ends at the end of this year and will not be renewed. To ensure time for processing, TWIC holders should apply by December 23, 2014. After December 31, 2014, current TWIC holders will no longer be able to obtain a replacement card extending the expiration date of their current TWIC by three years, and will have to go through the normal renewal process. Industry Newsbriefs -

Seaway Closure. The Montreal-Lake Ontario section of the St. Lawrence Seaway closes at 2359 on December 24, 2014. Any transit after that time is subject to prior written agreement. Vessels will be allowed to transit the Montreal-Lake Ontario section of the Seaway up to 1600 hours on December 31, weather and operating conditions permitting. The Welland Canal will close at 2350 on December 26, 2014. Transits after that time are subject to prior written agreement. Vessels will be permitted to transit the Welland Canal up to 1600 hours on December 31, weather and operating conditions permitting.

Advisor to Chamber of Marine Commerce. Retired RADM Michael N. Parks (US Coast Guard) has joined the Chamber of Marine Commerce as Special Advisor. He will be working with the organization to promote the economic, environmental and safety advantages of the binational Great Lakes/St. Lawrence Seaway shipping industry, in addition to increasing awareness and advising on the industry's maritime-related policy and issues. Prior to his 2013 retirement, **Parks** was Commander of the Ninth Coast Guard District.

US House committee on Transportation and Infrastructure. US Representative **Bill Shuster** (R-PA) was selected to serve again as Chairman of the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

Toxic Hotspots Removed. On October 30, 2014, the US EPA announced that two Areas of Concern – Deer Lake in the Lake Superior basin and White Lake in the Lake Michigan basin – have been removed from the binational list of toxic hotspots that were targets for cleanup under the 1987 US-Canada Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement.

US Merchant Mariner Credentialing. In October 2014, the National Maritime Center (NMC) announced that it had recently noted an increase in the number of applications submitted for Merchant Mariner Credentials in which applicants have not properly disclosed previous convictions in Section III of the CG-719B application form. As required by 46 Code of Federal Regulations 10.211 (a), "At the time of application, each applicant must provide written disclosure of all prior convictions not previously disclosed to the Coast Guard on an application."
